#### **DISCUSSION**

Upper Cumberland region is very low. The state average is around 60%; national average is 62%; and the Upper Cumberland will average in the midfifties. Several of the communities in the Upper Cumberland are in the 40% range.

#### **PROGRAM UPDATES**

### **EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MARK FARLEY**

Executive Director Mark Farley gave an update on the following:

- Highlights from the Area Agency on Aging and Disability Annual Report.
  - 144,276 congregate meals were provided across the Upper Cumberland
  - 107,484 home delivered meals were provided.
  - 7,833 trips for seniors
  - 323 applications were submitted for the TennCare CHOICES program and 246 were approved
  - Staff met one-on-one with 6,417 clients for the SHIP Program
  - Guardianship Program served 87 clients
  - Through COVID funds, thirty Telehealth sites have been set up across the region in the senior centers or housing complexes.

## DISCUSSION

Executive Director Mark Farley advised that USDA contacted the Development District because there is a contractor in Cumberland County that is interested in a program to develop low to moderate income housing. USDA has a site development program for residential housing and a non-profit or governmental entity can apply for the funding. The UCDD would purchase the property, bid the project and hire a contractor to complete the site development process. USDA would complete the mortgages to the homeowners. UCDD would develop the site, sell the sites to the contractor to build the homes and the contractor would need to have someone to purchase the house.

Executive Director Mark Farley asked if the board would be interested in the UCDD discussing the project with USDA.

After discussion, the board agreed that Executive Director can explore the idea and bring the information to the board at the December meeting.

Executive Director Mark Farley advised at the last board meeting we discussed a child care grant for a million dollars through the Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development and Tennessee Department of Human Services. The Development District was going to receive the grant to work with child care providers. The grant may need to go through the counties. ECD will send an email or letter to the County Mayors announcing that the grant is available. The Development District can administer the grant if it becomes available.

Executive Director Mark Farley advised that the agency foreclosed on the Pea Ridge Ioan in Clay County. The agency will incur a loss of \$9,062.51.
